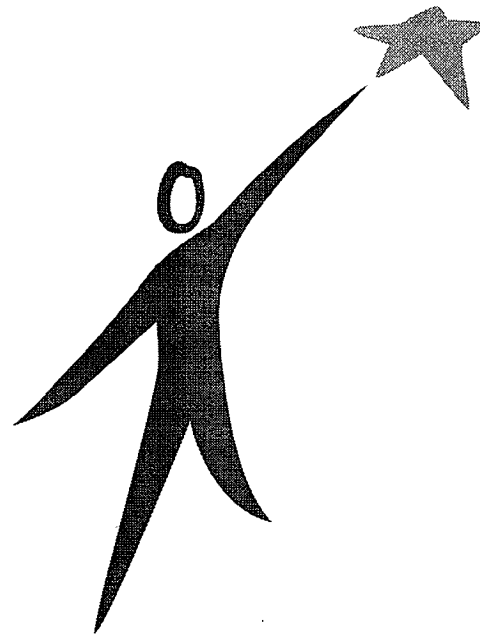


What is the Summer Program

YES Summer Program is a Medicaid funded program for students from 1st grade to 12th grade. Camp runs from June 23 through August 27th.

Each morning the student will be picked up by our Transportation Department around 7:00am. Breakfast begins at 8:00am and the day ends by 1:30pm. Camp participants should be home no later than 3:00pm.

A variety of activities have been planned focusing on "Leadership" to help our client's realize their full potential and their ability to be the leader of their own future. We take the clients on educational and therapeutic outings as well as take part in fun activities and trips.

Life Coach Therapeutic Day Treatment

The goal of the program is to prevent extended out-of-home placements of children and adolescents. The Day Treatment Program is a school based program. Services are a combination of psychotherapeutic interventions combined with education and mental health treatment. Participants receive activity therapy, recreational therapy, educational therapy, individual therapy and group therapy. Upon completion successful participants will have reached their identified goals, determined by their individualized service plan.

Intensive In-Home

Clients are under the age of 21 who are at high risk of being removed from the home, either because they are experiencing significant behavioral or emotional difficulties or because they have been subjected to abuse or neglect.

Wellness Center

The mission is to provide compassionate health care services to eligible persons residing in the Greater Richmond area. The Wellness Center includes psychiatric and other mental health services as well as medical diagnosis and medically necessary treatment of physiological and other persistent conditions not requiring a referral or in-patient hospital services. Care is directed toward health promotion, disease prevention, management of routine medical conditions, appropriate referral to specialty care in Richmond, and continuity across inpatient and outpatient settings. The clinic is staffed by a psychologist, psychiatrist, licensed mental health clinicians, a family physician, a nurse practitioner, a registered nurse, a licensed practical nurse, and a patient service assistant.

Frequently Asked Questions

Am I eligible for my child to attend the Program?

- If you receive Medicaid and your child displays behavioral or emotional difficulties you are encouraged to apply.

What do I need to bring with me to the Assessment?

- If your child is accepted you will need a copy of their recent physical and psychological evaluations. Also all Doctor's and medical information.

How do I apply?
